# Irish Olympian in water-polo (Reserve forward) (Amsterdam 1928)

- ¥ Named as entrants in both *The Irish Times* and *Freeman's Journal*, but not among the "Also Competed"; William Sexton was probably handicapped as the scratch swimmer given his record as Irish 440 yd Champion in 1920 and Leinster ¼ mile Champion in 1919
- ♦ Dublin City Analyst for 35 years, one of the founders of the Liffey Swim
- ♣ Captained Dublin University FC 1922–23; Capped twice for Ireland as flanker in 1922 against Scotland and England; captained Dublin University SC in 1921–22, Hon Secretary 1920–21
- ♥ *The Irish Times* and *The Freeman's Journal* both reported the winner's time as 28 min; the following year *The Irish Times* and *The Freeman's Journal* stated that the winner' time in 1921 of 27 min 31 bettered the winner's time in 1920 by 1 min 3 sec; *The Irish Independent* only recorded that the winner's time was 1 min 3 sec better than the winning time in 1920. *Swimming in Leinster 1894-1944* gives the time as 28:38, which is also recorded as that of J.J. Kennedy in 1922 in *The Irish Times*, *Evening Herald* and *Irish Independent*.

There were 41 starters from an unknown number of entries, of whom “over 30” finished (same statement in three different newspaper reports); it is unclear from press reports who of the “Also competed” finished the race. The named competitors in two press reports both tally at 42, 16 annotated finishers and 26 “Also competed”, indicating that one of the “Also competed” did not start. The time of 27 min 10 sec is reiterated in reports of the 4<sup>th</sup> Liffey Swim in 1923.

## 5<sup>th</sup> Liffey Swim

### Thursday 24 July, 1924, 18.30

At the 1924 Annual General Meeting of the Leinster Branch, Noel M. Purcell, in proposing the adoption of the Hon Secretary's report, stated that the Liffey Swim as then conducted was, in his opinion, a poor advertisement for swimming, albeit that the general standard of swimming had improved. As in 1921–1923 an official programme listing entries, cap numbers and handicaps was published for the race. The number of entries for the 1924 edition of the Liffey Swim is unknown
